Patient information

Many procedures are not covered by OHIP, as per the Schedule of Benefits instructions issued by the Ontario Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care (MOHLTC).

This brochure outlines which services are typically not covered by OHIP. Some exceptions are made with special authorization from the MOHLTC through the surgeon. Otherwise, the patient is responsible for the hospital component and the physician charges for all uninsured procedures and supplies.

Patients with private insurance may apply to their company for possible reimbursement for procedures directly. It is not the responsibility of physician or the hospital to deal with insurance companies.

The hospital fee will be refunded to the patient if the case is cancelled by the hospital or surgeon for medical reasons.

Frequently asked questions

What do charges include?

Fees include the cost to operate and staff the facilities (e.g. clinics, operating room, recovery unit), the use of equipment, medical surgical supplies and other expenses.

These fees do not cover physician or anesthetist fees and supplies ordered for you directly. Please discuss with your surgeon.

How will the cost of supplies be charged?

The physician will notify you of the costs of supplies, such as implants or prosthesis, and will charge you directly. However, in the event that the hospital purchases special supplies for you, the cost will be added to your invoice.

What is the charge for an overnight (inpatient) stay?

If an overnight stay is required following a cosmetic/uninsured procedure, the current resident or non-resident inpatient daily rate will apply. A Canadian resident should expect to pay \$1016.00 a day for a ward room.

Payment is required in advance for planned overnight stays. If admission is not required, the hospital will reconcile the charges and issue a refund. Please be advised there are additional charges for a semi-private or private room. For more information, please contact the finance department.

Where, when and how do I pay?

Patients can make payments by cash, debit, or credit card. The hospital accepts Visa, MasterCard, and American Express. Personal cheques are not accepted.

Procedures less than 30 minutes: For procedures in the Rouge Valley Ajax and Pickering (RVAP) ambulatory care unit (ACU) and/or the Rouge Valley Centenary (RVC) surgical clinics that are less than 30 minutes, **payment must be received the day of the procedure before it is performed.** Patients should pay the fee at the cashier office or by phone. A receipt will be required to register in the ACU or surgical clinics.

Procedures more than 30 minutes: For procedures in Rouge Valley's operating rooms and/or the RVAP and RVC ACU and surgical clinics that are more than 30 minutes, **payment is expected at least five business days prior to the procedure to pay.** Patients should pay at the cashier office or by phone. The procedure will be cancelled if payment is not received. There is a no show fee of 50% of the procedure costs, if the patient does not cancel within five business days or fails to show up for the procedure.
