Thanks to the huge success of the 2021 tournament, the annual Mayors' Charity Golf Classic was able to raise \$215,000 for the Jerry Coughlan Health & Wellness Centre being built in North Pickering.

When it opens later this year, this Centre will be a new medical centre bringing different health care services closer to home for people living in the area. Inside the modern multi-storey building the types of services expected to be offered include a range of Lakeridge Health outpatient services as well as independent physician offices, other health professionals and an urgent care centre. In addition, a pharmacy, laboratory and diagnostic services will be co-located in the building.

The 2022 Mayors' Charity Golf Classic is being held on September 15, and is raising money to fund a new incubator for the NICU as well as more defibrillators at Ajax Pickering Hospital.
